CHRISTIAN CONDUCT

Maintaining the highest standard of behavior before God and others is a God-given responsibility & privilege. **Individual liberty** is the reward for personal responsibility and given to encourage proper conduct and to correct improper behavior. As Christian ladies and gentlemen, we will "*abstain from all appearance of evil.*" Each student should be directly accountable at all times to a specific sponsor.

The **six-inch rule** will be followed at all times by all students and unmarried sponsors & guests. Students are not to isolate themselves from their group and must respectfully submit to all chaperons.

Sponsors & judges are to prohibit "booing," "hissing" or using flash attachments at inappropriate times. **Hoorays and hallelujahs** are always welcomed! **We cheer and celebrate!**

At no time will students be allowed in any vehicle without a sponsor. When necessary, busing will be provided. For emergencies please obtain permission from convention director or assistant before leaving campus. This is for medical, legal, and parental protection.

ATTENDANCE TO RALLIES

Sponsors and students must attend all rallies and sit together in the same area. **Those who are too ill to attend scheduled activities** are not to remain in their rooms, but must first go to their pastor, sponsor, or convention director for prayer. No student should leave a rally without a sponsor.

NAME BADGES & KEYS

Everyone must wear a name badge at all times. The only exception is while competing in athletic events. Name badges are to be worn in the upper-chest area. Replacement badges cost \$1 each from the registrar's office. Lost keys cost \$5.

BULLETIN BOARD INFO

There will be a bulletin board inside the Activity Building. This board is to be used by adults only. All announcements will be posted on this board.

MODEST APPEARANCE

The dress code in the *ACTS Student Convention Guidelines Handbook & Addendums* must be observed at all times. Your manner of appearance and dress reflects an image of refinement and self-discipline. Moderation and modesty are the basic principles that govern our attitudes and appearances. **Showing respect and deference at this convention for rules & standards is expected & deeply appreciated.**

GENTLEMEN

All gentlemen must wear buttoned-up dress shirts with collars and conservative slacks. Athletic shoes may be worn for athletic events only. Belts must be worn with trousers that have belt loops.

Dress button shirts with collars, ties, and dress shoes (not tennis shoes) are to be worn to **evening meals, evening rallies, and Award's Service.**

No more than the one top button can be left unbuttoned when a shirt is worn without a tie at other non-performance events.

LADIES

All ladies must wear hosiery at all times of neutral colors. No decorated or outlandish hosiery will be permitted. No "bobbie-socks" except while competing in athletic events. No shorts or athletic apparel above the knees. **Thank you for projecting an image of Christian respect and modesty.** Our emphasis is for ladies to look respectfully dressed-up for this leadership convention. **All ladies must wear dress clothes to evening meals, evening rallies, and Award's Service.**
