Housing

All students are directly responsible to their sponsors at all times. Each room must have one resident sponsor.

- All room assignments are final.
- All personal items must be labeled with your name, address, and school name. Sponsors should care for all their student's money and valuables.
- All students and unmarried sponsors &
- guests will observe the six-inch rule at all times.
- Areas in front of ladies' dorm rooms are off-limits to all gentlemen. Areas in front of gentlemen's dorm rooms are off-limits to all ladies. Remember: godly respect & Christian testimony.
- Report all damages or needed repairs.
- Always knock before entering a room. Do not enter another room if no one is present.
- Limit showers to 5 minutes each.
 - There will be a daily inspection of all rooms; they must be neat & orderly.
- Nightly prayer & devotions are to be held in each room before 11:30 p.m.
- Lights must be turned out by 11:30 p.m. and "quiet" must prevail. This shows
- respect for others on campus and homeowners nearby.
- Towels changed on Wednesday only.
- Each room must be clean and all trash bagged and set outside of room before leaving LWCC.
- Rooms must be inspected and signed out by room inspector before leaving.

DRIVE-IN VISITORS

LWCC charges drive-in visitors \$7 per person, per day. To receive your visitor's pass, see the Activity Building Desk Clerk. Visitor's passes must be worn at all times.

THE SPIRIT OF EXCELLENCE AWARD

Spirit of Excellence Awards are the most highly valued awards. Students and sponsors will be evaluated by their demonstration of godly character traits like friendliness, attitude. sportsmanship, neatness, politeness, obedience, participation, and Spiritual devotion. participating school will cast two votes for the school (s) demonstrating these traits. Each judge will also cast one vote. All Spirit of Excellence Award votes must be given to the convention director or ACTS office by Thursday evening. This will be the last award given at the Friday evening service.

RIBBONS, AWARDS, & TROPHIES

These are awarded to the top contestants in each of the nearly 150 categories and will be presented early during evening services. All display entries (art, photography, needle and thread, science, etc.) will be available for viewing after the judges have completed their judging. (Please do not touch or remove any other contestant's entries.)

New Minimum Requirements for Placing in Events:

(Highest 3 scores receive the award)

ONE 1st place ribbon ONE 2nd place ribbon ONE 3rd place ribbon

(Exception: ties will each receive a ribbon)

1st Place minimum score must be 94%

2nd Place minimum score must be 87%

3rd Place minimum score must be 80%
