

# Elementary School Supply List

## 2012-2013

### Kindergarten

- Small book bag or backpack
  - Art/Pencil box
  - 4 pocket folders
  - 1 bottle of glue & 4 glue sticks
  - 6 pencils (no mechanical pencils please)
  - 2 erasers
  - Crayons – 8 count preferred
  - Blunt-tip scissors (Fiskars brand recommended)
  - 1 box of Kleenex
  - 1 container of antibacterial/disinfectant wipes (any size)
  - Pair of tennis shoes to be left at school for gym time
- Optional Items:
- Small blanket and pillow for afternoon rest times
  - Change of clothing to leave at school in a plastic bag

### First Grade

Please label all supplies with your child's name.

- 2 boxes of 24 ct. Crayons
- Markers (optional)
- Scissors (Fiskars are preferred)
- Glue
- Pencils
- 2 Large pink erasers
- Pencil or art box (small enough to fit in desk)
- 3-ring binder (1" max.)

- Bible (King James version) – Please talk with Sis. Johnston prior to purchasing
- Box of Kleenex
- Container of Sanitizing wipes
- Coins for Math-2-Quarters, 10-Dimes, 5-Nickels, 10 Pennies
- Boys: snack size baggies
- Girls: Sandwich size baggies

## Second Grade Supply List

Please label all supplies with child's name or initials

- Backpack
- King James Bible
- 3 ring binder (choose size wisely – must fit in desk)
- 2-pocket folder
- School box to hold their scissors, glue, colored pencils, etc.
- 2 Black dry erase markers (Expo brand last longer)
- Pencils
- 2 large erasers (such as the chunky pink ones)
- Colored Pencils and a small sharpener
- White glue (we can refill)
- Scissors (Kid Fiskars are great)
- 2-3 boxes of tissues (Kleenex, Puffs, etc.)
- Boys: 1 container of cleaning-type wipes (Lysol, Clorox, etc.)
- Girls: 1 container or refill of hand wipes (such as wet ones, Huggies baby wipes)
